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Interacting with Oncology Orders

Non-oncology providers/staff **MUST NOT** interact with any oncology-related treatment orders, such as modifying or cancelling orders. Changes to orders that are part of a patient's treatment plan can have negative downstream effects and pose a significant risk to patient safety.

For any questions or concerns regarding oncology-related orders while caring for the patient, **DO NOT** make any alterations to them. Instead, contact the oncology provider of the patient for further discussion. This avoids any potential issues resulting from canceling treatment orders which ensures high-quality and safe care for the patient.
