
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Interacting with Oncology Orders

Non-oncology providers/staff MUST NOT interact with any oncologyrelated treatment orders, such as modifying or cancelling orders. Changes to orders that are part of a patient's treatment plan can have negative downstream effects and pose a significant risk to patient safety.

For any questions or concerns regarding oncology-related orders while caring for the patient, DO NOT make any alterations to them. Instead, contact the oncology provider of the patient for further discussion. This avoids any potential issues resulting from canceling treatment orders which ensures high-quality and safe care for the patient.






NEDS (New England Donor Services) Referral

Question: How should NEDS be contacted in the event of a heart beating death or asystolic death of a patient?

Answer: NEDS request that they are initially contacted electronically rather than by a phone call. This is done within the **Patient Expiration** iView band.



Question: What is the benefit of contacting NEDS electronically vs. placing a phone call?

Answer: Patient information goes to NEDS once Yes, heartbeating referral or Yes, asystolic referral is documented.


The flow of information to NEDS decreases the amount of time the nurse needs to spend on the phone with

NEDS. In addition, the NEDS Referral Number auto populates in the patient EHR.

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Tandem Heart Documentation

The Adult System Assessments, ED System Assessments, and Adult Crit Care System Assessments iView band has been updated to include the **Tandem Pump Current** within the **Hemodynamic Measures**. The addition allows providers to measure the trend of the Tandem Heart ventricular assist device more accurately.



Last Unknown BM Update

The **Assessments** component of the Nurse Handoff MPage has been updated to include **Last Unknown BM** date. When documented in in the Gastrointestinal section of the Adult Systems Assessment Interactive View and I&O bands, **the Last Unknown BM** date displays in the **Assessments** component of the Nurse Handoff MPage. The update allows clinical staff to document and track **Last Unknow BM** more accurately.
