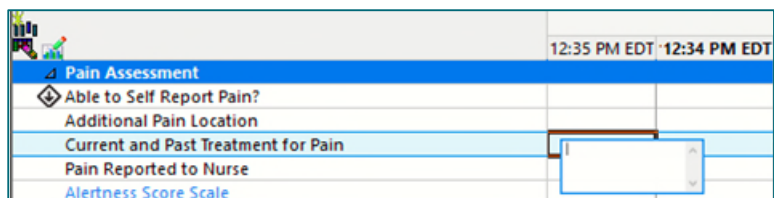


## Pain Assessment

The Pain Assessment section within Interactive View and I&O has been updated. When documenting **Current** and **Past Treatment** for Pain, the last charted value no longer pulls into the comment/free text box field.



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## HealthInfoNet (HIN)

Health InfoNet is a Maine specific website which hosts medical information submitted by participating hospitals, provider offices and labs. Staff can connect to a patient’s Health InfoNet record from within their NLH medical record. If a patient has a duplicate record within HIN, you must contact HIN to help remedy the issue.

## Central Line Dynamic Group

### When should a Central Line Dynamic Group be inactivated?

A Central Line dynamic group should only be inactivated if the line is removed. Keeping the Central Line dynamic group active allows the dynamic group to be seen across encounters if the patient is readmitted or seen as an outpatient.
