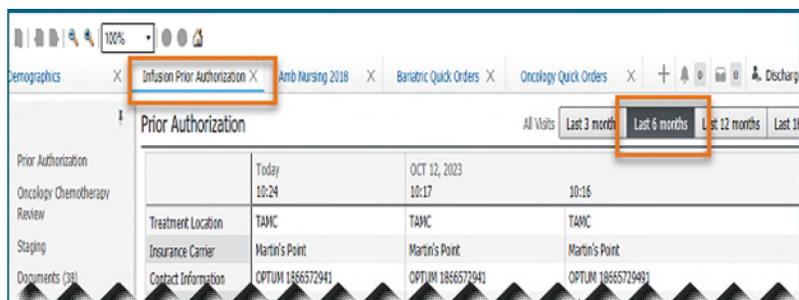


Oncology Infusion Prior Authorization Component

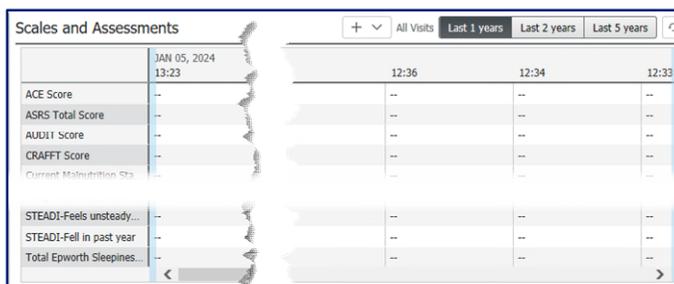
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Scales and Assessment Component

- Handoff

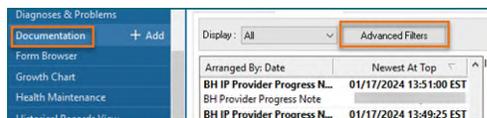


Acadia Inpatient Provider Note Types Updated

The note type names were updated for Inpatient Behavioral Health Admission and Progress Notes.

Updated Note Type Names:

- BH IP Provider Admission Note
- BH IP Provider Progress Note

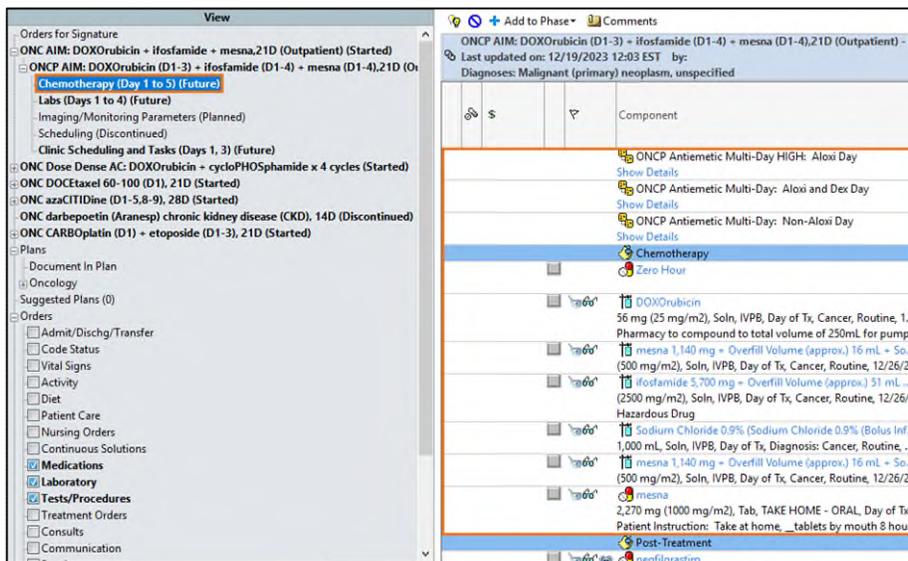


As a reminder, any existing custom document search filters need to be updated to include the updated note type names.

Viewing Oncology Regimen Treatment Orders

Where can I view medications the patient is receiving as part of their treatment regimen?

- Medications ordered as part of the patient’s treatment regimen will not appear on the medication list or medication reconciliation window, except for any prescriptions prescribed from within the regimen (i.e., oral chemotherapy, antiemetics, pre-treatment med scripts, etc.).
- When an oncology provider orders a regimen, the orders are placed in a future state so they can be activated on the day of treatment.
- There are two ways to quickly see medications that have been ordered as part of the patient’s treatment regimen:
 1. View the **Chemotherapy** phase of the regimen(s) on the Order Profile. This includes orders for chemotherapy as well as other treatment meds: hydration, pre-meds, and antiemetics.
