PowerTrials – Patient Protocol Manager Edit Enrollment on a Protocol

Patient Protocol Manager is one of two major components of the PowerTrials solutions. Patient Protocol Manager (PPM) is used to enroll and manage enrollment of patients into studies.

Taking a Patient Off Study

STEP 1: Log into **Patient Protocol Manager**.

STEP 2: Select the applicable **Initiating Service** from the list and locate the protocol you wish to take the patient off study.

STEP 3: Locate and right-click the patient's name that is to be taking off study and select View/Edit Enrollment.

STEP 4: Select the **Off-Study** tab.

• Enter the date you removed the patient in the Off-Study Date box.

• Enter the Removal Person, Removal Institute, and Removal Reason information.

NOTE: If the Study Type of Therapeutic was selected when creating the protocol, there will be three tabs available: Enroll, Off Treatment, and Off Study.

NOTE: For Non-Therapeutic studies, there will only be two tabs: Enroll and Off Study. The Off Treatment and Off Study tabs contain the same fields

NOTE: A free-text comment must be entered if you select Other from the Removal Reason list.

STEP 5: Select **OK**.


• The patient's details are updated. The applicable column (Off Study or Off Treatment) is updated with the date entered that the patient was taken off.

SmartZone Alert


- ➤ A SmartZone alert will appear in the patient's chart when staff enter the chart. In order for the alert to fire and appear, the following events need to occur:
 - Once the protocol has been built and the patent is enrolled into the study.
 - After the patient has been enrolled into a study, the SmartZone alert will trigger upon opening the chart.

NOTE: When a patient is off treatment the Smart Zone alert will still appear until they are taken off study.
