Cross Venue Changes

Advance Directive PowerForm

- Updated first question in PowerForm to correctly populate the banner bar once PowerForm is signed.

Nutrition Screen

- Duplicate weight being removed from Nutrition Screen section of PowerForm.


Dose Range Checking

- Dose Range Checking is getting a new content update. During the update, The Dose Range Checking will be turned off. Once the update is complete, a notification will be sent that it can be used again.

Emergency

ED Reportable Cases Form

- A new ED Reportable Cases form will be available in FirstNet.
 - The form is to document if a social service entity was contacted or to report any alleged abuse, animal bite, or assault.



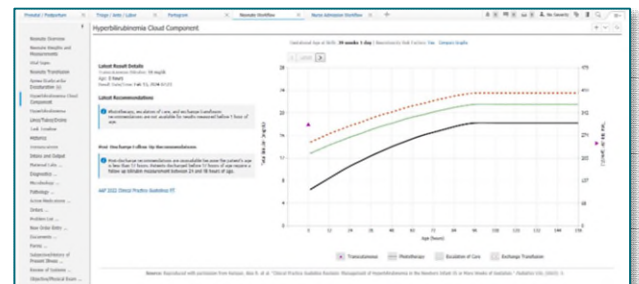
ED Physician Workflow MPage

- Combined Note Links will be removed.
- History and Physical (H&P) Note link will be added to the ED Physician Workflow MPage.

Women's Health

Neonate Workflow MPage

- Hyperbilirubinemia Component will be updated with latest 2022 American Academy of Pediatric Guidelines.
- In order for the component to open and show information the workflow requires the following documentation to take place:
 - Gestational Age at Birth (recorded in Hyperbilirubinemia Details PowerForm or the Newborn Admission History Assessment).
 - Patient Age (pulling from registration).
 - Neurotoxicity Risk Factors (Newborn Admission History form, Newborn Phototherapy iView section).
 - Bilirubin Results.



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Pharmacy

Routes of Administration Update

- Certain Routes of Administration will be inactivated and standardized routes will be updated to replace them.
 - The update will occur in phases, pharmacy will be required to select new appropriate route.

NOTE: Providers must address their favorites with expiring routes by April.

Unverified Orders Monitor Tab

- Unverified Orders Monitor Tab within Inpatient Pharmacy Medication Manager is no longer supported.
 - A similar view can be setup in Pharmacy Patient Monitor in PowerChart.

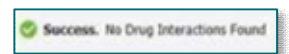
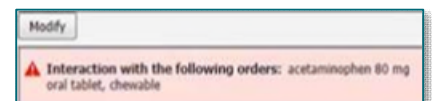
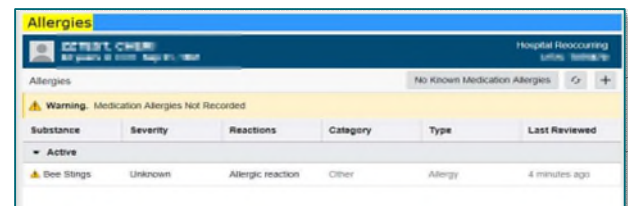
PathNet Blood Bank

- Default Label Printers will default to the user's workstation.
 - Other printers at the facility will not be viewable.

Future Changes

To Be Determined

- Allergies will be updated to a more user-friendly experience. The update will occur in patient's charts, forms, scheduling appointment book, Pharmnet, and Radnet.
 - There will be no change to Workflow MPages at this time.
- Reverse Interaction Checking will automatically run each time new allergies are entered and can also be run at any time by clicking Reverse Allergy Check button.
 - If **interaction is found**, a red warning populates with details. This is not auto dismissed.
 - If **no interaction is found**, a green checkmark with text **Success. No Drug Interaction found**. The message will auto-dismiss after five seconds.
