Pain Alert


When a second prescription for a narcotic analgesic pain medicine is entered during a 90-day period, a pain alert will fire. The alert asks if chronic pain should be added to the problem list and recommend a pain assessment. If chronic pain is already on the list, then the alert is suppressed.

Intake Form Update

The following forms will be updated to open in the Summary section instead of the ID Risk Screening section:

- Bright Futures Intake Adolescence (11 to 21 years)
- Bright Futures Intake Early Childhood (12 months to 4 years)
- Bright Futures Intake Infancy (Birth to 9 months)
- Bright Futures Intake Middle Childhood (5 to 10 years)
- Comprehensive Intake
- Medicare Visit Form / Medicare Annual Wellness Visit



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Colorectal Cancer Screening Recommendation

- Colorectal Cancer Screening will now combine and replace the following recommendations:
 - Colorectal Cancer Screen (Colonoscopy)
 - Colorectal Cancer Screen (Occult Blood)
 - Colorectal Cancer Screen (Sigmoidoscopy)
 - Colorectal Cancer Screen (Fecal DNA)
 - Colorectal Cancer Screen (Fecal Immunochemical Test)
- Undo cancellation
 - New feature to undo a cancelled recommendation under the Recommendation component.



Case Management

Consult to Social Services

- Consult to Social Services will automatically fire if there is a positive screening in any of the following SDOH PowerForms:
 - Social Determinants
 - Social Determinants PREPARE
 - Well-Rx Questionnaire
 - AHC Health Related Needs Screening Tool
- In addition to the consult, a task will also fire to the Acute Case Management Worklist and MPTL.

Pharmacy

Routes of Administration Update

- Certain Routes of Administration will be inactivated and standardized routes will be updated to replace them.
 - The update will occur in phases, pharmacy will be required to select a new appropriate route.

NOTE: Providers must address their favorites with expiring routes by May.

Future Changes

To Be Determined

- Allergies will be updated to a more user-friendly experience. The update will occur in patient's charts, forms, scheduling appointment book, PharmNet, and RadNet.
 - There will be no change to workflow MPages at this time.



Modify

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- Reverse Interaction Checking will automatically run each time new allergies are entered and can also be run at any time by clicking the Reverse Allergy Check button.
 - If **interaction is found**, red warning populates with details. This is not auto-dismissed.
 - If **no interaction is found**, a green checkmark with text **Success. No Drug Interaction Found**. This message will auto-dismiss after five seconds.



Anesthesia Risk Section Update

 Anesthesia/Sedation and General Anesthesia Risk Assessments sections will be combined into one section General Anesthesia Risk Assessment.

Surgery Adhoc Folder Uplift

- The **intraoperative folder** will be removed and any forms that are not surgery related will be under the **Other** folder.
- The update will include the following folders:
 - ASC, Preop (PAT and Preop), PACU/Postop/Endo, Pediatric Surgery, and PRO Tools.
- The following forms will be updated and/or consolidated:
 - ASC Quality Data Reporting
 - FRAIL Assessment
 - HOOS, JR. Adult Hip Survey
 - KOOS, JR. Adult Knee Survey
 - PROMIS Global 10
- **Postoperative Phone Call** form will replace the following forms:
 - Postoperative Follow-up Phone Call
 - Postoperative Phone Call ASC
 - Post-Operative Phone Call ASC
- **Preadmission Assessment** form will replace the following forms:
 - Endo Preadmission Assessment
 - Preadmission Phone Assessment
 - Preadmission Visit Assessment
 - Surgery Preadmission History & Assessment
 - Visit History and Assessment ASC
