


## From the Office of Clinical Informatics Ambulatory Diabetes Educator Diabetes Self-Management Education and Support Documentation Workflow

May 3, 2022

The Diabetes Educator Intake AdHoc form is used to document Diabetes Self-Management Education and Support (DSMES) program visits. The DSMES Accreditation Report pulls documentation from the Diabetes Educator Intake form that can be used for ADA and ADCES Accreditation purposes.

## **DSMES Visit Documentation**

- <u>STEP 1</u>: Open the patient's chart from the **Ambulatory Organizer**.
- STEP 2: Click the + button to add the Endocrinology Workflow MPage, if needed.
- **STEP 3**: Click the **Diabetes Flowsheet** component.
- <u>STEP 4</u>: Click the drop down beside the + button to select the Diabetes Educator Intake form.
- <u>STEP 5</u>: Complete the Diabetes Educator Intake form as necessary for the patient.



NOTE: The Diabetes Educator Intake form will pull in last documented values in most sections;

therefore, it is important to review the entire form to ensure it is up to date.

The HPI and Assessment & Plan sections of the Diabetes Ed/Nutrition Note will pull from the

Workflow MPage and the Diabetes Educator Intake form.


<u>STEP 6</u>: Click the green checkmark in the upper left corner of the form

to Sign.

<u>STEP 7</u>: Navigate back the Endocrinology Workflow MPage.

**STEP 8:** Select the **Diabetes Ed/Nutrition Note** from the **More** button

in the Create Note section.

<u>STEP 7</u>: Use the /dsmes\_program\* auto text to pull documentation from the Diabetes Educator Intake form into the note.

NOTE: Modifications to the Diabetes Educator Intake form will display as strike throughs in the Text Rendition of the document. When the /dsmes\_program\* auto text is used to pull in documentation, the modified text will not display a strikethrough in the note.

## **DSMES Accreditation Report**

The DSMES Accreditation Report can be run from the **Reporting Portal** to abstract documentation in Cerner needed for ADA and ADCES accreditation.
