The Referral Review MPage has been created to allow CCOM staff reviewing incoming referrals to view information in the patient's chart in a single location. The following flyer outlines how to use the MPage components.


Referral Review MPage

- ➤ Accessing Referral Review MPage from PowerChart:
 - Navigate to the **Menu** in the patient's chart and click the **Referral Review** tab.
 - The Referral Review MPage will display.

➤ MPage Elements

The following elements can be used within the components to assist with locating information efficiently in the patient's chart.

- Component Header: Click the Component header allows you to navigate to the appropriate section of the patient's chart to where you can view information, as needed.
- Look-Back Ranges: These buttons allow you to select the time range for which you want to see results in the component. For example, click Last 24 Hours to display the appropriate patient information in the component for the last 24 hours.



• Ambulatory View: This button allows you to view the component in the Ambulatory view, with columns labeled Latest and Previous. A single column may group results that have different dates or times.




• Flowsheet View: This button allows you to view the component in the Flowsheet view. In the Flowsheet view, a column is displayed for each date and time with charted results.



> Referral Review MPage Components:


By clicking on or scrolling through the workflow components, staff will be able to locate information in the patient's chart from this one view when reviewing incoming referrals.

- Patient Information: Patient specific information can be viewed here. Information populates from data entered in the registration process.
 - Addresses
 - Contact Information
 - Emergency Contact
 - Health Plans
- **Referral Orders:** Lists any active or inactive Referral Orders that have been placed for the patient.
 - The default lookback range is 7 days. Results can also be filtered by look-back range for orders in a specific time range.
- Care Team: Displays the patient-centered care team for both clinical and nonclinical members who are involved in the patients care.
- **Documents:** This component allows users to see clinical documents with the patient's chart.
 - Clicking the document name will open a detail pane, which allows you to see additional document details as well as a preview of the document.





- You can filter documents by look back range, document types, and encounters.
- Clicking the Change Filter button will allow you to quickly filter specific note types into view.
- **Diagnostics:** Allows you to view diagnostic information for a patient.
- Labs Flowsheet: Displays laboratory results in both a flowsheet view and in an ambulatory view.
- Microbiology: View microbiology orders and results.
 Results in the Microbiology component can be filtered by look-back range.



- Pathology: Component allows you to view Pathology orders and results. Results in the Pathology component can also be filtered by look-back range for orders in a specific time range.
- Surgical History: Displays the patients documented surgical history.
- Outstanding Orders: Orders that have not been completed will be listed.
