
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Acute Care Managers can access IPASS to easily view documentation entered by providers. This information will be helpful in determining the patient's discharge needs.

IPASS

Providers use this structured handoff tool to discuss their patients' Illness Severity, Patient Summary, Actions, and Situation Awareness. These details allow the providers to synthesize the patient's condition.

- Illness Severity: Displays the patient's illness severity as documented by the provider. The selection chosen will be reflected in the wording of the IPASS icon.
- Patient Summary: Allows clinicians to add or edit a patient summary to assist in the hand-off of patient care to another clinician using the Physician Handoff view. Located at Medical Service Level
- Actions: Displays follow-up items entered by providers in the view to provide better continuity of care. Can only be edited by the person who created the entry.



• Situation Awareness: Allows for communication between physicians who share a patient's care.

Accessing IPASS

The IPASS tool can be accessed from any of the MPages within Care Manager View.

- On the toolbar on the right side of the MPage, click the IPASS icon.
- The IPASS window displays information entered by the providers caring for the patient.
 - If multiple Care Teams are associated with the patient, click the drop down to select a new team.
- After reviewing the information, click anywhere outside of the IPASS window to close.

<u>IMPORTANT</u>: No documentation is to be performed in the IPASS component, as this functionality is for viewing purposes only.
