## Ancillary Overview



The CareView Dashboard is an interactive visual management tool used during discharge progression huddles. Identified staff can access each unit's board to prioritize tasks on patients pending discharge in the DBN, R/Y/G and Milestones columns.


#### **CareView Dashboard Access**

A QuickLink is available allowing access to the dashboard from any device. Click the + to add to the list for ease of future access.

From the Storefront, click the icon associated with the desired unit and enter your Cerner credentials.



### **Dashboard Overview**



- Click the Filter tab, then select Indicators to choose which Barrier to display.
  - For instance, click the *Green: today* option to view patients expected to discharge during the day, or the *Lab Results* to identify patients who may need a specimen collection.
  - Once there, look for icons in the *DBN* column to prioritize tasks.

#### **Pertinent columns**

- ➤ RN and CNA: names of assigned staff in Clairvia will display.
- ➤ <u>DBN</u>: icon will display for patients expected to Discharge by Noon.
- $\triangleright$  R/Y/G: indicates discharge readiness, Red two days; Yellow one day; Green ready to discharge.
- Attributes: patient attributes will align with Capacity Management icons.
- ➤ <u>Milestones</u>: icons relate to discharge progression, **Anticipated** no dot or *In progress* green dot.
