#### Abstract

The Chronological View MPage provides a single area of the chart to view pertinent information from the patient's encounter. Clinicians can use Chronological View for reviewing patient records during patient handoff and quality assurance. The clinical information displayed in the milestone sections includes tracking events, vital signs, orders, patient movement, and documentation in chronological sequence.


## Adding Chronological View MPage

$>$ Add View: Allows the ability of adding Chronological View to the new ViewPoint.
> Click Chronological View under Select a View.


## Features of Chronological View MPage

Chronological View provides a comprehensive view of the patient's encounter.

1. Day Marker Row: Displays automatically before any other categories at the beginning of each day with a calendar icon followed by the date.
2. Checkin Tracking Group Row: Displays a building icon with the tracking group name and facility followed by the check-in date and time.
3. Key Section: Displays the name of the key section with the name of the events selected.
4. Encounter Event Label: Displays the name of the encounter event type.
5. Time Stamp: Displays the time the tracking event was placed in a certain status.
6. Event name and Status: Displays name of tracking event and status.
7. User: Displays the full name of the user that completed the activity.
8. LOS: Displays the patient's length of stay at the point the activity was completed.


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$>$ The Time column can be sorted by ascending or descending order.
$>$ Blue hyperlinks allow the ability to view forms or notes.
