

# From the Office of Clinical Informatics Clairvia Web Notification Preferences June 20, 2022


The Clairvia Web solution can be set up to send notifications to the user regarding Clairvia, such as changes to the schedule, status of requests, shift swaps, open opportunities, and shift alerts.

### **Notification Types**

- Schedule Notifications
  - These are sent when changes are made to the user's schedule.
- > Request Notifications
  - These provide updates to the details of your requests and changes in status (approval or denial).
- > Shift Swap Notifications
  - These provide updates with the details of **Shift Swap** request and changes in status (acceptance from invitee, approval from manager, etc.).
- Opportunity Notifications
  - These provide updates with the details of the opportunity that has been signed up for, as well as updates on status (approval or denial).


# **Setting up Notifications Preferences**

From the menu, select Tools  $\rightarrow$  My Information  $\rightarrow$  Preferences.





End users can select preferred notification(s) by placing checkmarks in additional boxes and clicking Save.





### **Shift Alert Tab**

Select the **Shift Alert** tab and select the preferred method of receiving notifications of urgent openings.

➤ This step can be completed separately for each profile/unit the end user has permission to float.

NOTE: If a preferred email is not showing, navigate to Infor Cloudsuite and update the information.
