

From the Office of Clinical Informatics FirstNet Code Stroke Documentation May 3, 2024

The time of first stroke symptom onset to the start of treatment is a crucial factor in helping to determine a patient's outcome after a stroke. The Joint Commission requires all ED nurses to document Code Stroke Time Called.

<u>Documenting Code Stroke Time Called in the Prearrival Form</u>

The **Prearrival Form** may be used to document **Code Stroke Time Called** prior to patient arrival.

- Select Add Prearrival from LaunchPoint.
 - Document the Code Stroke Time Called.





Documenting Code Stroke Time Called and Telestroke Services in ED Triage


From the ED Triage form, select Stroke from Demonstrates Signs and Symptoms of Stroke.



- The **Stroke Symptom Details** window opens.
- In the **Code Stroke Time Called** field, document the time the Code Stroke was called.
- In the **Were telestroke services provided** field document **Yes** or **No** by selecting the appropriate radio button
 - If Yes is selected, the Telestroke Service Location field must be completed.

NOTE:

If Telestroke services are provided later, the ED Triage form can be modified from Form Browser to document the Telestroke Service Location.



Reviewing Documentation

- ➤ Code Stroke Time Called can be reviewed in the Stroke section of the ED Systems Assessments Interactive View and I&O band.
- ➤ **Telestroke Service Location** can be reviewed in the **ED Triage Adult** Form in Form Browser or the Chronological MPage.
