

## From the Office of Clinical Informatics NL CA Dean Hospital Discharging Outpatients in FirstNet

October 5, 2023

Patients receiving non-emergent care at NL CA Dean Hospital Emergency Department will be registered to the CA Dean Treatment Room. Emergency Department nurses providing patient care, can access the patient chart following the steps below.

## Creating a Patient List

A patient list allows emergency department nurses at NL CA Dean Hospital to access non-emergency registered patients receiving treatment within the Emergency Department without the need to navigate to PowerChart.

- **<u>STEP 1</u>**: Select **Patient List** from upper toolbar in FirstNet.
  - If the Patient List is hidden, use the toolbar options to reveal hidden buttons.
- **<u>STEP 2</u>**: Add **CA Dean Treatment Room** to Active lists.
- <u>NOTE</u>: Click <u>here</u> for more information on how to add Patient lists.

## **Discharging Patient**

Patients receiving care from the CA Dean Emergency Department registered to the CA Dean Treatment Room can be discharged from FirstNet.

- **<u>STEP 1</u>**: Select patient from CA Dean Treatment Room patient list.
- **<u>STEP 2</u>**: Navigate to **ED Nursing Workflow** MPage.
- **<u>STEP 3</u>**: Select **Discharge** under End Visit.
- **<u>STEP 4</u>**: Select the appropriate discharge conversation when prompted, i.e., home, etc.

<u>NOTE</u>: Use the Discharge process as outlined above, as the PM Conversation button is not available within FirstNet.
