
On June 16, 2020 the Non-Fatal Strangulation Assessment AdHoc form will be available in FirstNet. The form was developed for Emergency Department nurses to document injuries incurred from strangulation. Once the assessment has been documented and saved to the patient chart, providers can tag the text rendition into their Dyn Doc note from the document component on the ED Workflow MPage.

## Clinical Non-Fatal Strangulation Assessment

STEP 1: From the patient chart, select the AdHoc button in the toolbar.


Click the box to the left of the Non-Fatal Strangulation Assessment.



**STEP 2:** The Non-Fatal Strangulation form consists of 3 sections: Strangulation Assessment, Airway/Breathing/Circulation Assessment and Physical Assessment.

> Complete all desired fields within the form, click the green check mark to save to the chart.

**NOTE:** 

Most fields within the Non-Fatal Strangulation form will flow to their coinciding section within the ED Systems Assessment I-View band, the exceptions are the fields in the Strangulation Assessment section of the form.

**STEP 3**: A task will fire to the LauchPoint tracking board if Yes is selected for Wound in the Physical Assessment section of the form. This task will open I-View so that the wound assessment can be documented.



- Navigate to LaunchPoint.
- Click Nurse Activities.
- Select document to open the Wound

Care section in Activities View. Wound Care Document all appropriate fields in the Wound Care section.
