

From the Office of Clinical Informatics Cerner Millennium Documenting Rehab Forms Given to Patient

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It is a Federal requirement to document an Inpatient Rehab patient has received two specific inpatient documents. To meet compliance, there is a documentation field on the Admission History Adult PowerForm in the Education Needs section.

<u>Inpatient Rehab Forms</u>

- ➤ Before performing an assessment using the inpatient rehabilitation facility assessment instrument, the rehabilitation facility must give the patient the following forms:
 - 1. Privacy Act Statement Health Care Record
 - 2. Data Collection Summary for Inpt Rehab

Documenting the forms have been given to the patient

- The patient does not need to sign these forms.
- It must be documented in the EHR (Electronic Health Record) the patient received the forms.
- To document, navigate to the **Admission History Adult** PowerForm, which is found in AdHoc or can be accessed on the MPage summary under the **Admission Documentation** component.
 - 1. Once on the PowerForm, click the Education Needs documentation section.
 - 2. At the bottom underneath **Inpatient Rehab** Forms Given to Patient, check the boxes indicating the patient received the forms.
 - 3. Once completed, click the green checkmark to sign the form.
