

From the Office of Clinical Informatics Cerner Millennium COVID-19 Banner Bar

March 21, 2022

The Banner Bar gives clinicians a face-up indicator of a patient's COVID-19 status. Users can quickly and easily view if an order has been placed or view the patient's test result, if available. The COVID-19 demographics bar looks across the patient's orders and encounters to return the latest documented result.

Banner Bar Updates

Four different statuses with the corresponding date/time ordered or resulted are displayed based on the status of the COVID-19 order.

• **Not Ordered:** Will display if there is no COVID-19 result and no outstanding order in the patient's chart.

COVID-19:<Not Ordered>

PUI Ordered: Will display in the banner bar if the patient has COVID-19 order placed and is waiting on lab result.

COVID-19:PUI Ordered(03/21/2022

• Not Detected: Displays if the lab result is negative.

COVID-19:Not Detected(08/26/2020

• **Detected:** Displays if the lab result is positive.

COVID-19:Detected(05/05/2020 09:..

IMPORTANT: If a patient has a repeat test, the banner bar will not re-flag to display a PUI Ordered status; however, it will retain the first result until the repeat test is posted.

NOTE:

The PUI Ordered status will not display in the Banner Bar when the Administrative Order for COVID-19 is placed since the test is used to for patients who don't have symptoms and are either 1) going for an aerosol-generating procedure, 2) required for discharge to a nursing home or Acadia Hospital, or 3) a woman who presents in labor or 24-48 hours prior to a scheduled C-Section. All other statuses display as described above.
