

The Preprocedure Workflow View is set up for the surgical nurse to improve chart review in one area of PowerChart which is necessary in the perioperative area. This is a move from the Admission and the Handoff Workflow Views that are being used by Inpatient nurses.

### Changes or New Components in the Preprocedure Workflow View

Components can be rearranged. Click and drag the components in any order to suit your workflow.

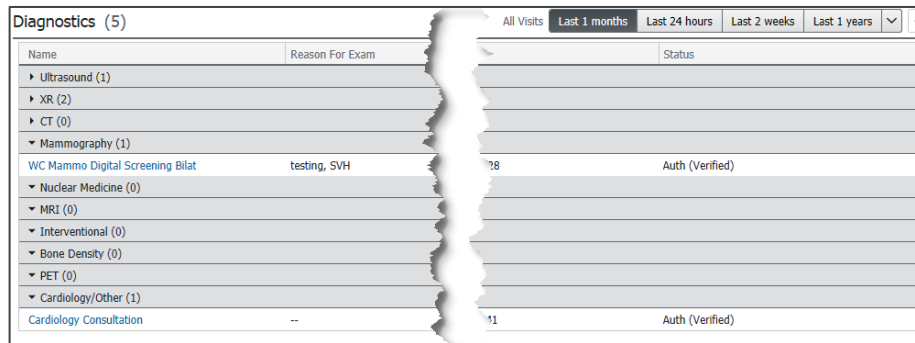
#### ➤ Admission Documentation

- The drop down in the component shows forms and iView documentation that pertains only to the surgical nurse.



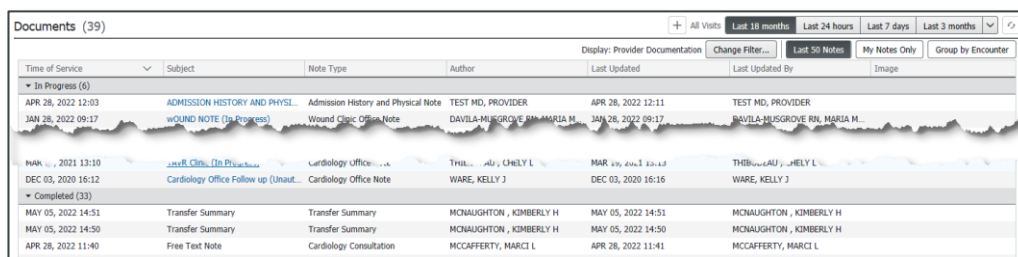
#### ➤ Diagnostics

- The component provides links to diagnostic results and documents. This is similar to the Imaging component that is in Handoff page and is broken out in categories.



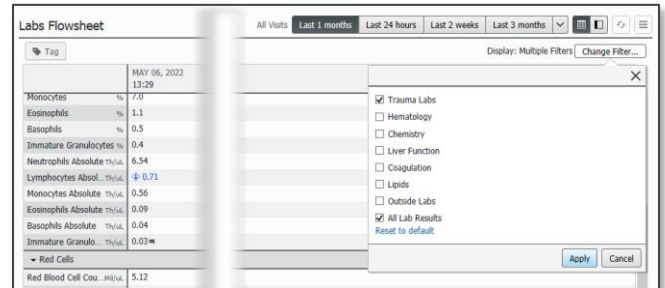
#### ➤ Documents

- The component shows notes from providers. Use the component to look for H&Ps or Consultation Notes.



➤ Labs Flowsheet

- Instead of going to Results Review, use this component instead to look for labs. Using the filters helps find the lab results needed much quicker. This is similar to Handoff Labs Flowsheet component and will provide more filters.



➤ Order Profile

- This component shows all orders with the similar view of Orders in the Table of Content with easier way to filter and group orders.
