

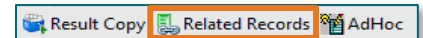
The Antepartum Record will cross from the Ambulatory to the Inpatient setting for continuity of care throughout the patient's pregnancy. All members of the healthcare team will have access to the information necessary for delivering high quality care.

Antepartum Record

The Antepartum Record will provide valuable data to Pediatric and Emergency providers related to the pregnancy beginning with the first prenatal visit.

➤ Pediatric Clinician Access

STEP 1: From the baby's chart, in the toolbar, select **Related Records**.

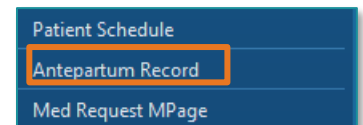


STEP 2: Confirm the patient and click **OK** to be directed to the mother's chart.

STEP 3: Within the mother's chart, select **Antepartum Record** in the Table of Contents Menu.

➤ Emergency Clinician Access

- The Antepartum Record will be accessed from the Table of Contents Menu.



➤ Antepartum Record

- The Antepartum Record is a **view only** document that contains information such as:

- Pregnancy Summary
- Problems
- Antepartum Note
- Prenatal Exam and Notes
- Blood Types and Anti-D Immune Globulin
- Prenatal Tests and Lab Results
- Measurements
- Genetic Screening
- Gestational Age (EGA) and EDD
- Infection History
- Menstrual History
- Anesthesia and Transfusions
- Birth Plan and Requests
- Education
- Registration and Pregnancy Information
