Pharmacy Antimicrobial Stewardship Program (ASP) Renal alerts fire when a Serum Creatinine result is significantly different from the previous value within the last 72 hours and a selection from a list of IV anti-infectives is ordered.

Renal Alerts

This alert rule will fire in the Clinical Surveillance Worklist when a Serum Creatinine result is significantly different from the previous value within the last 72 hours and a select list of IV anti-infectives are ordered.

- Review data triggering the alert in the Clinical Surveillance Worklist
 - Click into the **Alert** column.
 - The "Safety 50% SCr Change (SCr>1)On Renal Abx" alert is seen.
 - Review detailed patient information.


True Actionable Alert


- Move alert to **In Progress/Intervention** in the status drop-down.
 - Staff may select In Progress, complete the intervention form, then return to update status to In Progress/Intervention or Completed/Intervention depending on site workflows.
- After review of the documentation, return to the Worklist and click the Blue plus sign within the documentation column.
 - Select the Antimicrobial Stewardship Intervention form.

<u>Antimicrobial Stewardship Intervention form documentation</u>

- STEP 1: Choose the applicable intervention type in the Recommendation section, such as Dose Adjustment.
- STEP 2: In the Prescribed Drug section, select the Antibiotic (free text) option to activate the Generic Drug window and enter the appropriate medication names. Then select Not Applicable in the Proposed Drug section.
- STEP 3: Select an option specific to the patient in the **Infection Source** section.







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STEP 4: Enter **Prescriber** Name.

STEP 5: Choose the applicable service in the ASP Provider Service section, the appropriate Prescriber Response, and enter applicable Contacted Via method.

STEP 6: Briefly describe the intervention in the **Comment** section.

<u>STEP 7</u>: Click the green check if document is complete.



NOTE: This document may be saved at any time during charting with the floppy disk icon. To adjust or add to a saved note access it through the form browser or through the hyperlink in the documentation column. Once on form browser, highlight the note, right-click in the body of the note and Modify.

STEP 8: Finalize by clicking into the Alert column and change the alert status to Completed/Not Duplicate.



➤ Not a True Actionable Alert

- Move alert to **In Progress** in the status drop-down.
- Click the Blue plus sign within the documentation column.
 - Select the Antimicrobial Stewardship Intervention form.
 - Select Other in the **Recommendations** box and enter "*False Alert*".
 - Provide brief description in the Comment section at the bottom of ASP form and click the green checkmark to complete.
- Click into the Alert column and change the alert to Dismissed.
 - Enter applicable time frame for alert dismissal.
