

## From the Office of Clinical Informatics Inpatient Pharmacist Discharge Order Notification

March 13, 2023

Inpatient Pharmacists play an important role in ensuring smooth transitions of care while patients are discharged from the hospital. This flyer outlines a new process for selective notification of the Pharmacist upon patient discharge order placement.

## **Option in Pharmacy PowerForms**

A **Notify pharmacy when Discharged** field will be added to the PowerForms below to prompt twofold notification to the pharmacist when an electronic **Discharge Order** is entered. Check box to notify pharmacist when Discharge ordered.

When the field's radio button has been selected in any of the above PowerForms and a **Discharge Order** has been entered, the following will occur...

- <u>NOTE</u>: Order Comments will contain the name of the PowerForm used to initiate the notification. The PowerForm should contain details about why the notification was requested. If **Notify pharmacy when Discharge** was selected on multiple forms, the last charted PowerForm will be listed.
- Multi-Patient Task List: Pharmacy Consult Patient Discharge

When the Pharmacy Consult is finished, chart Done to complete the task.

<u>IMPORTANT</u>: Once **Notify pharmacy when Discharged** is selected and the PowerForm is signed, the discharge notifications will fire even if button is deselected on subsequent PowerForms.
