



# NOTICE OF FORMULARY CHANGES

## REGARDING COVID-19 VACCINE INVENTORY

In response to FDA's deauthorization of COVID-19 MONOVALENT vaccine products, Northern Light Formulary Management Oversight Committee (FMOC) has voted to remove all MONOVALENT COVID-19 vaccine products from formulary.

FMOC has also voted to remove Moderna COVID-19 Vaccines for **pediatric patients less than 12 years of age** due to safety concerns surrounding potential for dosing errors with current product labeling.

Moderna BIVALENT COVID-19 vaccines are **unavailable** for **pediatric patients less than 12 years of age** as these products have been removed from formulary effective immediately. Moderna products remain available for patients 12 years and up.

### WHAT ACTION IS NEEDED?

1

**IMMEDIATELY** Quarantine ALL monovalent COVID-19 vaccine doses of Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna products. Inventory for all quarantined vaccine will be sent to the inpatient pharmacy for disposal. The inpatient pharmacy will be reaching out to coordinate.

**IMMEDIATELY** Quarantine all inventory of Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine vials with Dark Pink Cap and Yellow Labeling 'BOOSTER DOSES ONLY Ages 6m through 5y' (shown to the right)

This product has been removed from Northern Light Formulary.

Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine Vials with Dark Blue Cap and Label with Gray Border (shown to the right) should be used for **ONLY patients 12 years and age or older.**

This product should NOT be used for patients less than 12 years of age. Providers may use age-appropriate Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine product for patients less than 12 years of age who are due for a dose of bivalent vaccine.

Adult patients and those 12 years or older may continue to receive this bivalent Moderna product as eligible.
