



As required elements are completed, the red asterisk becomes a green checkmark.


➤ Problem List



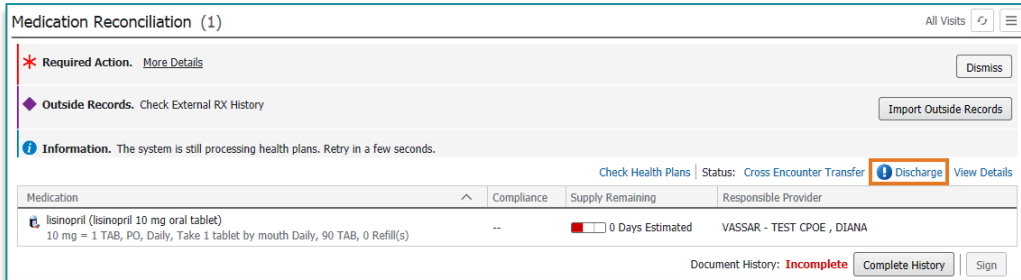

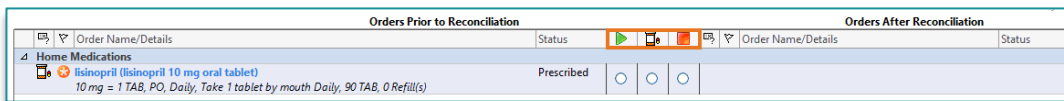

➤ Medication Reconciliation

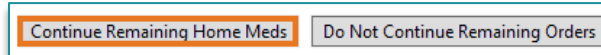
- To satisfy the requirement, you need to complete the Discharge medication reconciliation.



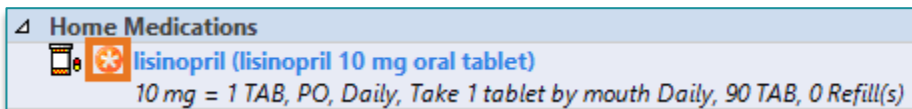
- Click the blue hyperlink, Discharge.
- Select Continue, Prescribe, or Stop for each medication.



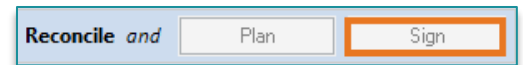
- If the medication is one that you do not manage, you do have the option to select Continue Remaining Home Meds.



- All medications with an Orange Starburst need to be addressed.

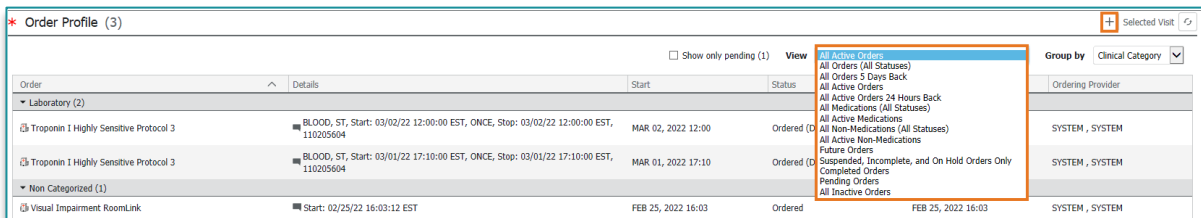


- When completed, select Reconcile and Sign.

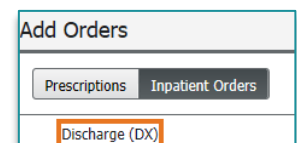


➤ Order Profile
