



Optimization of Respiratory Therapy documentation is happening on December 9, 2019. These changes will improve their workflow and retire antiquated tools and processes. With these changes come upgrades to endotracheal tube reposition orders and completing transfer or cross-encounter medication reconciliation of respiratory therapy medications for NLH providers.

### Reposition Endotracheal Tube Order Update

With the Respiratory Therapy upgrade, the **Reposition Endotracheal Tube** order will be discontinued, and **Withdraw Endotracheal Tube** or **Advance Endotracheal Tube** orders will be available instead. Choosing the specific withdraw or advance order will save the provider from having to select Advance or Retract within their endotracheal repositioning order details.



### Medication Reconciliation When Transferring Level of Care

When performing a **Transfer** or a **Cross Encounter Transfer** medication reconciliation, please **continue** any nebulizer treatment tasks if applicable to the patient. This will keep those tasks from disappearing off the respiratory therapy task list.

- In the example, every 4-hour NEB is the medication, and the ONCE NEB is the Respiratory Therapy task. Please continue both during a transfer.
