

# From the Office of Clinical Informatics Women's Health View Provider ViewPoint July 28, 2020


On August 17, 2020, PowerChart Maternity will be going live. The implementation of this solution will cross from the ambulatory to the inpatient setting improving the continuity of care provided throughout the patient's pregnancy and ensures all members of the healthcare team have access to information necessary for delivering high-quality care. This flyer will review the process for utilizing the Provider ViewPoint.

### **Provider View**

The Provider View is the view that you will see when you are in your patient's chart. There are multiple MPages that will be utilized depending on your patient care setting. There are viewpoints for Ambulatory and for Inpatient. This flyer will review the various MPages and how to customize the pages to fit your needs.

# > Ambulatory


Prenatal




- The Prenatal MPage will populate once the patient has an active pregnancy.
- From this MPage, the progress of the pregnancy will be viewable.
- Links to FetaLink monitoring episodes are available from this MPage.
- Components specific to prenatal care are on this MPage.
- GYN Clinic



- The GYN Clinic MPage will be utilized for postpartum and GYN office visits.
- Components specific to Gynecology are available on this MPage.
- Quick Visits can also be initiated from this MPage.
- WH Quick Orders



- The WH Quick Orders page is broken down into categories for orders that are most commonly ordered in Women's Health.
- Demographics



This MPage has demographic and insurance information available.

- Additional information includes Administrative documentation.
- Patient Information Administrative is available as well which contains information such as preferred name and which family members information can be shared with.
- Refill MPage



- This MPage was designed to assist with the refill process.
- Information such as documents, recent labs, PMP information, last visits and the home medication list can be found on this page.
- Prescriptions can be ordered from this page as well.

## Inpatient

Triage/Ante/Labor




- This page will be used from the time that the patient presents for triage till she delivers.
- Partogram



- Once a labor onset date and time have been documented, the Partogram begins populating.
- Information on this page includes: Partogram, Labor Curve, Maternal Labor Assessments, Contractions, Fetal Heart Rate, Fetal Assessments, Maternal Vital Signs, and Maternal Physical Assessments.




Postpartum Inpatient



- After your patient has delivered, documentation will be found on the Postpartum Inpatient MPage.
- Components in this MPage are associated with the Postpartum patient.
- GYN Inpatient



- This MPage will be utilized for your non-OB patients.
- Components in this MPage are associated with the GYN inpatient.
- Discharge
  - Required elements will be indicated by a red asterisk.
  - This MPage will be used at discharge from the inpatient encounter.




• As elements are completed, the red asterisk will turn to a green checkmark to indicate that the required element has been met.

### Customizing MPages


- Moving Pages
  - The position of the MPage can be moved to the position that you desire.
  - Click and drag the MPage to the position, when the MPage is where you want. Release your mouse.



- Customizing Components
  - From the drop-down in the upper right-hand side of the pages, click the drop-down and highlight the word components.
  - The available components will be in view.
  - Components on the various MPages can be dragged to the position that you prefer.
    - This is done by highlighting the name of the component and dragging it to the position desired.



- Components can be hidden from view by removing the checkmark in front of the component from the list of available components.
  - To return the component to view, follow the same process.



• To revert to the default view, from the drop-down, select Clear Preferences.



There will be a pop-up box confirming the action requested.
