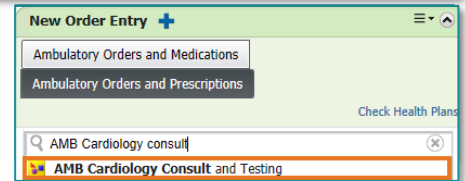
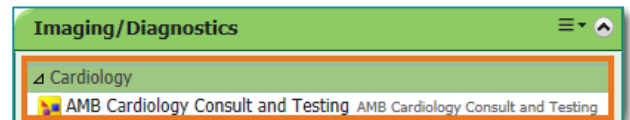
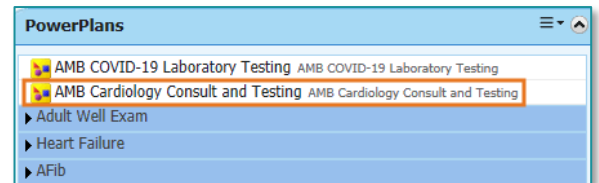


The AMB Cardiology Consult and Testing PowerPlan is inclusive of consult requests, testing, and combination consult/testing requests for all ambulatory locations at Mercy and Maine Coast Hospitals.

Locating the PowerPlan Order

The PowerPlan, titled AMB Cardiology Consult and Testing, can be found as follows:

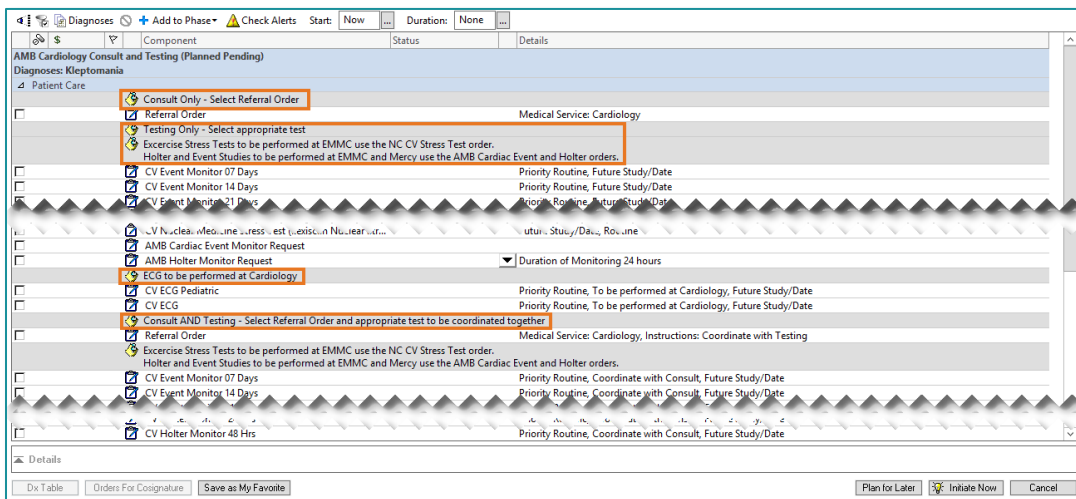
- Primary Care Quick Orders page within the PowerPlans component.
- Oncology Quick Orders page within the Imaging/Diagnostics component under the Cardiology section.
- For all other providers – search for the plan using the New Order Entry component on your Quick Order page.



Using the PowerPlan

The PowerPlan is divided into 3 sections:

- Consult Only
- Testing Only
- Consult AND Testing



NOTE: If the member organization is not available in the Performed at Field then the study is not available at that location.

STEP 1: Select the appropriate checkbox(es) applicable to the patient.

STEP 2: Fill in any required **order details**, as indicated by a blue circle with a white X, by double-clicking the **Details** column of the order.

STEP 3: Select the **Initiate Now** button.

STEP 4: Select the **Orders for Signature** button.

Locating the Orders

Due to the nature of these orders and how they are addressed, the orders display in various lists for staff to coordinate with Cardiology:

➤ **Multi-Patient Task List (MPTL)**

- When selected, the testing orders will automate a task within the MPTL.

➤ **Referral Management**

- The referral order, when selected, is in the Referral Management outgoing worklist.

How Orders Are Managed?

➤ **Consult Only orders:**

- Staff manage these like other referrals to Cardiology via the Referral Management tool.

➤ **Testing Only orders:**

- Staff manage these from the MPTL and send a Message Center message to the appropriate pool or staff can contact Cardiology or Central Scheduling department via phone.

➤ **Consult AND Testing orders:**

- Staff manage the referral portion from Referral Management. With the addition of the order sentence that states **Coordinate with Testing**, this alerts Cardiology staff to navigate to the patient's Single-Patient Task List (SPTL) and/or Orders profile to see the applicable Cardiology testing orders and coordinate with the Consult appointment.
