


Maternal Depression Screening is available in the Recommendations component on Workflow MPages for ages 0-1 month, 1-3 months, 3-5 months, and 5-7 months.

Documenting Maternal Depression Screening

The Edinburgh Postnatal Depression Scale should be completed at the 1, 2, 4 and 6 month Well Child Check visits. This screening is to be done at time of intake. Based on office preference, this can either be completed by paper form or the electronic PowerForm included in the Pediatric Ambulatory Intake form.

NOTE: Providers use the Recommendations component to choose an action item. Within the drop-down, there is an option to place a charge order if screening is completed. Providers should also follow current practice for referrals if one is needed.





Maternal Depression Screening Charge Order


STEP 1: From the Recommendations component of the Ambulatory Workflow MPage, select **Maternal Depression Screening**.

STEP 2: Once selected the screen opens to the right and shows information about the recommendation as well as **Actions**. Select the drop-down arrow for **Actions**. This brings up options to order, Cancel Permanently, or to chart as Refused.

NOTE: Placing the charge order does not generate a task to the Single or Multi-Patient Task list.

Satisfying the Recommendation

The recommendation is listed under **Pending** until it is satisfied. To satisfy the requirement, an **Action item** needs to be selected. When satisfied, the recommendation is listed under **Not Due/Historical**. This screening is prompted at each Well Child Check for ages 0-1 months, 1-3 months, 3-5 months, and 5-7 months. Once the patient has aged out of this recommendation, it is no longer listed under **Pending**.
