

# Prom the Office of Clinical Informatics Quick Reference Guide (QRG) Netsmart – Start and End a Visit April 26, 2023

This Quick Reference Guide (QRG) reviews how to document the start and end of a patient visit in Netsmart.

### Start and End a Visit

When entering a patient's home, you will need to document the start of the patient visit; conversely when leaving the home, you need to document the end of the visit.

# **Common Buttons & Icons**

Start Visit	Start Visit button
End Visit	End Visit button
•	<b>Undo</b> arrow

### Start a Visit

> From the Today screen:

**STEP 1**: Tap the visit type displayed on the patient's visit line.

• The patient's chart displays.

**STEP 2**: Tap Start Visit.

NOTE: Tapping Start Visit logs your start time and GPS coordinates for Electronic Visit Verification, or EVV, which is required by the state of Maine.

**STEP 3**: Proceed with the patient visit.

### **Undo a Visit**

➤ If you need to return to the Today screen and undo the start visit action, from the Today screen:

**STEP 1**: Tap Today in the upper left-hand corner of the screen.

<u>STEP 2</u>: Tap the arrow on the patient's visit line.

- A Confirmation to Continue message displays. Tap Yes.
- The time and arrow no longer appear on the patient's visit line.

STEP 3: Navigate back to the patient chart and repeat the Start a Visit steps.

## **End a Visit**

> From the patient chart screen:

**STEP 1**: Tap End Visit.

<u>STEP 2</u>: Have the patient or applicable caregiver sign the screen.

**STEP 3**: Tap Done.

NOTE: Do not tap Done to end the visit until you leave the home. This will allow for the actual time

you leave to align with the EVV system.
