Document and forward any additional questions that you are unable to answer to the appropriate member of the team. Do not leave concerns open-ended; YOU are responsible for following up.

Ensuring Patient Safety is of the utmost importance during a go-live period. Should you become aware of any incident that results in patient harm, do encourage the EMHS staff person closest to the incident to submit the incident through their usual Risk Management tools, but also relay the incident to your Elbow Support supervisor so that they may relay it on to the appropriate persons within the Command Center. It may not always be obvious as to whether the patient harm was a direct or indirect result of the introduction of the new EMR tools and workflows. The Command Center will want to work swiftly with Risk Management to quickly drill to root cause and mitigate for others. Your relay of this information will assist with that process.
