# **WIC Intake Form**

On **Tuesday, April 16**, several updates will be made to the **WIC Intake Form** to incorporate screening for postpartum preeclampsia risk. These changes will be made to expedite treatment for patients presenting with symptoms of postpartum preeclampsia.

If "Yes" is selected to the "Is patient up to six weeks Postpartum?" question, a Postpartum Preeclampsia Symptom screening will open to allow clinical staff to assess the risk for postpartum preeclampsia. The update improves patient safety by evaluating risk factors for postpartum hemorrhage.


#### **Pregnancy Status**

  - The appropriate answer to the question(s) should be selected using the options available.






## **Postpartum Preeclampsia Symptoms Section**
