On **Monday, May 20**, the **Acute Therapy** folder in **Adhoc** will contain new forms to be used on **acute patients** in the hospital. The implementation of the Acute Therapy forms will alleviate the printing issue with the IRF forms displaying more information than necessary on acute patients.

The **Adhoc folder structure** has been changed to have the Acute Therapy folder in first place allowing the folder to default open.

• Lives With located in the Home Environment section will now display different options based on the patient's age.


