Partnership Student Nurse Pyxis Update

On Wednesday, May 29, Partnership Student Nurses at NL Inland Hospital, NL Maine Coast Hospital, and NL Sebasticook Valley Hospital will be able to perform removal transactions on Pyxis MedStations under the supervision of their preceptor. This is being done to comply with State of Maine Board of Pharmacy regulations.

Partnership preceptors will need to witness these transactions on devices in which partnership student nurses remove medications. Preceptors should be present and overseeing each medication removal and witness those transactions in real time.

IMPORTANT: This change only applies to Partnership Student Nurses and does not include nursing students completing their clinical rotations.
