



Transfusion Charge Capture

On **Tuesday, June 4**, a **CareCompass** task will be implemented prompting **Transfusion Charge Documentation** by nursing when blood or blood products are administered. The CareCompass task to document charge capture will decrease the number of transfusion charges that are currently being missed.

Charge Capture Process

- When **Transfusion Start Date/Time** is documented in **Bridge Blood**, a task will go to CareCompass prompting the nurse to document transfusion charges.
- Clicking **Document** in CareCompass will open the **Transfusion Charge Documentation Form** where the charges will be documented.
- Select the facility and nursing unit in which the blood or blood product is being administered and sign the form.
