

## Breast Cancer Risk Assessment PowerForm Update

On **Wednesday, March 13**, the **Breast Cancer Risk Assessment PowerForm** will be updated to include additional documentation to meet the Breast Cancer Risk Assessment standards. The update will increase efficiency by moving from paper to electronic documentation, eliminate the need for faxing to the reviewing provider and scanning to the chart, and will allow providers to effectively review patient data within the Electronic Health Record (EHR).

### New Sections

- Family History of Cancers
  - Cervical, Ovarian, and Colon Cancers
- Hormone Use
  - Use of Birth Control and Hormone Replacement
- Nodule
  - Found Via Palpable or Mammogram
