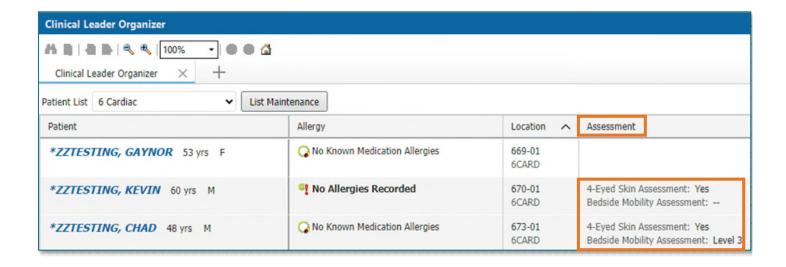


Clinical Leader Organizer Update

On Monday, March 18, the 4-Eyed Assessment column name in the Clinical Leader Organizer (CLO) will change to Assessments. The BMAT score and the 4-Eyed Assessment documentation will populate the column. Adding the BMAT score on the CLO along with other quality indicators assists the charge nurse with improving quality and preventing poor patient outcomes.

NOTE: If BMAT is not documented, a hash mark will display as seen in the screenshot.
