



## Clinical Leader Organizer Update

On **Monday, March 18**, the **4-Eyed Assessment** column name in the **Clinical Leader Organizer (CLO)** will change to **Assessments**. The **BMAT score** and the **4-Eyed Assessment** documentation will populate the column. Adding the BMAT score on the CLO along with other quality indicators assists the charge nurse with improving quality and preventing poor patient outcomes.

**NOTE:** If BMAT is not documented, a hash mark will display as seen in the screenshot.
