



Postpartum Preeclampsia Risk WIC Intake Form

On **Tuesday, April 16**, several updates will be made to the **WIC Intake Form** to incorporate screening for **postpartum preeclampsia risk**. These changes will be made to expedite treatment for patients presenting with **symptoms of postpartum preeclampsia**.

If “**Yes**” is selected to the “**Is patient up to six weeks Postpartum?**” question, a **Postpartum Preeclampsia Symptom** screening will open to allow clinical staff to assess the risk for postpartum preeclampsia. The update improves patient safety by **evaluating risk factors for postpartum hemorrhage**.

Pregnancy Status

- **Pregnancy Status** will be added to the **OB/GYN** section.

Postpartum Patients

- If “**Yes**” is answered to “**Is patient up to six weeks Postpartum?**”, the **Postpartum Preeclampsia Symptoms** section will open.
 - The appropriate answer to the question(s) should be selected using the options available.

Postpartum Preeclampsia Symptoms Section

- A red asterisk (*) has been added to identify **Risk Factors for Postpartum Hemorrhage**.
- A **Postpartum Preeclampsia Communication Alert** will appear after **YES** is indicated for any **Postpartum Preeclampsia Symptoms**.
