











This flyer reviews the process and steps for the Inpatient COVID-19 Laboratory PowerPlan.

Selecting the Orders

- The new section, **For patients having more than one Aerosol Generating Procedure**, will be added to the _ COVID-19 Laboratory Testing PowerPlan. 
- Please continue to use the single-line, **Administrative Test for COVID 19**, for **Asymptomatic Patients** undergoing single-event AGPs.
- Use the new linked  orders when the patient meets either of the following inclusion criteria:
 - Inpatients that have serial AGP procedures and no new or worsening symptoms consistent with COVID.
 - Inpatients with continuous AGP procedures such as CPAP or BiPAP and no new or worsening symptoms.
- Because the two orders in the, **For patients having more than one Aerosol Generating Procedure**, section are linked, clicking one of these orders will automatically select both.
 - The first, orders an **Expedite, ONCE** test.
 - The second, orders a COVID test be done again in three days (3-day offset) and every three days, thereafter (for the remaining 11 days).
 - **Together, these orders request COVID testing for a 14-day period.**

For patients having more than one Aerosol Generating Procedure:			
- Inpatients that have serial AGP procedures and no new or worsening symptoms consistent with COVID			
- Inpatients with continuous AGP procedures such as CPAP or BiPAP and no new or worsening symptoms

- If an immunocompromised patient needs to be retested during their Post Infection Window (90 days after laboratory confirmed illness or 90 days from the onset of symptoms), select the order below the Immunocompromised Patients box, **COVID 19 NASOPHARYNX, Expedite, ONCE**.

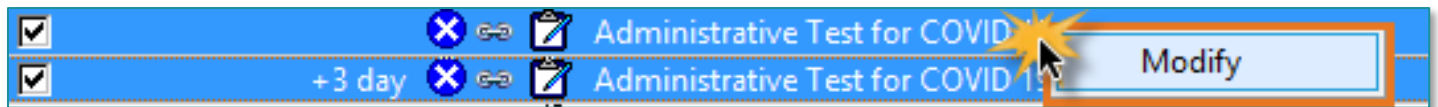
 Immunocompromised Patients:			
- Patients on chemotherapy for cancer			
- Untreated HIV infection with CD4 T lymphocyte count less than 200			
- Prednisone use of greater than or equal to 20 mg/day for more than 14 days.			
- If it is felt an immunocompromised patient needs to be retested during their Post Infection Window (90 days after laboratory confirmed illness or 90 days from the onset of symptoms), order PCR testing and contact Infectious Disease for consultation.			
<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>		 COVID 19	NASOPHARYNX, Expedite, ONCE When obtaining COVID 19 and respiratory panel only one swab is required.

- This triggers a test that Infection Prevention can use to help drive decisions related to releasing isolation precautions.

Modifying the Orders

If appropriate, these orders may be modified. Selecting one order for modification will automatically open the second order for modifications.

STEP 1: Highlight both **Administrative Tests for COVID-19** orders by holding the control key on the keyboard and clicking each order.



STEP 2: Right-click either of the orders and choose **Modify**.

- If both orders have been highlighted, the shared details will be updated for both orders concurrently. This allows the ordering provider to complete the various required details once.

STEP 3: Click **Initiate Now**.

STEP 4: Click **Orders for Signature**.

STEP 5: Click **Sign**.

NOTE: As with all PowerPlan orders, the Start Date/Time will automatically update when the order is Initiated.
